Fri., Nov.25 / Sat., Nov. 26

Leave U.S. for Bali from San Francisco. **Note:** The EVA Air flight most people are on leaves just after midnight on Saturday, Nov. 26, so actual **check in for flight will be Friday night, Nov. 25.**

Sun., Nov. 27

Enjoy the luxury of being well-fed (also liquored up, if you're into that), reading, watching movies, or snoozing on your overnight flight. Sleep as much as you can (Ambien, Sonesta, and Tylenol PM helps, if you're into that), so you'll be ready for fun upon arrival.

Sun., Nov. 27 or Mon., Nov 28

Notice the Balinese music and the aroma of flowers in bloom as you arrive in Denpasar, Bali. You'll be met outside baggage claim by someone holding a "**Connecting Cultures Travel**" sign. We'll gather your luggage and take you to a hotel on the boardwalk of **Sanur Beach**, where we'll be staying through Tuesday night.

Monday, Nov. 28 Trip Orientation at 10:00 a.m.,

then the rest of the day free, with fun options like purposeful laziness, beach swims, \$8 outdoor massages (yes, for an hour), or a boat trip to the island for diving or snorkeling.

Tuesday, Nov. 29

Free day with the same options as the day before, but tonight, we'll either be doing Karaoke or our own talent show.

NOTE: Before leaving Sanur, please make sure you have your Balinese ceremony clothing. This includes a short-sleeved shirt (one from home will do), a sarong (rectangular piece of cloth), and a sash to wear as a belt. Guys, your sarong needs to be long enough to cover your knees. The style for ladies' sarongs is closer to your ankles. (These can be purchased in Sanur.)

Wednesday, Nov. 30

Eat well at breakfast, because today we check out and start our day having fun with our girls at **Widya Asih IV Orphanage**. From there, we head north for our Balinese Eco-Village Cultural Immersion Experience. Our host families will be waiting for us at **OmUnity Bali**, our base of operations for the next 4 days.

NOTE: At OmUnity Bali, we'll be guests of **Sudaji** village, staying in groups of 2-6 at local guest houses. Our three delicious meals per day (which Jana and Jay personally sampled last January) will be gathered from the organic gardens of Sudaji, then cooked and delivered to us at OmUnity Bali by the women of the village.

OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES at OmUnity Bali

Before breakfast, you can practice yoga with ZanZan, our host. After breakfast, we'll have "Expedite Your Evolution", an interactive playshop opportunity to make your evolution easier. *Ready to have fun letting go of some limiting beliefs?* This is where it happens!

Thursday, Dec. 1 thru Sunday, Dec. 4

Every day is free at OmUnity Bali, where you can create your own experience, just as you'd like it to be. Our guide will be with us every day of the trip, to help you do what you'd like best. You can be busy at OmUnity Bali, or relax. Be involved, or escape for peace and quiet. At OmUnity Bali, you get to choose.

Monday, Dec. 5

We're off to **Ubud** today, Bali's most popular stop, where, if you want, you can meet (and even have treatments by) the real-life characters of Elizabeth Gilbert's *Eat, Pray, Love* book. Ketut, the wise man, and Wayan, the medicine woman, are easy to make appointments with if they're there, but get ready. Ketut's advice to most women is, "You need more sex."

Tuesday, Dec. 6 thru Thursday, Dec. 8

Free days in Ubud, with many options for you to choose from, like a hiking to the top of the nearby volcano to see the sunrise, or bussing to the volcano, eating a meal, and then leisurely riding bikes back to Ubud. Whether you're looking for something excessively active or luxuriously lazy, Ubud has it all!

NOTE: If it is possible with their school schedule, we will have the girls from the orphanage come to visit us for our traditional pool party and lunch, which we take up a collection to provide. We'll let you know, closer to the trip, if the pool party will be possible. We have many free days on this trip, and if you would like to spend time at this orphanage, or any other, we can help you get transport and make the arrangements for your visit.

Friday, Dec. 9

You'll leave Bali and arrive in San Francisco on the same day. If your flight arrives late in SF, we can suggest an inexpensive Travelodge (usually around \$50) nearby with a free airport shuttle. Or, you can call your airline, resign from your commitments, and join Jana and Jay as international hostel dwelling vagabonds!
